



BOTTLED BEER / LAGER



Sierra Nevada Pale Ale 5.6% £4.40

A pale ale with spicy and peppery aromas from the hops, balanced by biscuity malt and citrus. In the mouth there is a superb balance of tart hops, juicy malt and tangy fruit. A lingering finish offers a hint of vanilla pods and marzipan before it becomes dry, bitter and hoppy but underscored by sweet malt. A beautifully balanced and wonderfully refreshing beer.

Goose Island IPA 5.9% £3.20

This IPA recalls a time when ale shipped from India to England was highly hopped to preserve its distinctive taste during the journey. The result is a hop lover's dream with a fruity aroma set off by a dry malt middle and long hop finish.

Brooklyn Lager 5.2% £3.20

An award-winning amber-gold beer with a superb balance of sweet malt and refreshing bitterness with a floral hop aroma. The aromatic qualities of this beer are enhanced by a process known as dry-hopping.

Samuel Adams Boston Lager 4.8% £3.00

Since 1984, Samuel Adams Boston Lager has only used the finest hand-selected ingredients to create this full-bodied and original brew. A beer which offers a full, rich flavour that is both perfectly balanced and yet complex in character.

Duvel 8.5% £4.20

A distinctive golden pale ale with an extra long maturation period. Developed in 1923, its name derives from the expression 'een echten duvel' meaning a real devil. A devilishly tasty beer from Belgium!

Budvar 5% £3.20

Brewed with nothing but local natural ingredients in a 100 days brewing cycle, of which 90 days are spent fermenting. Budvar from the Czech Republic, is universally regarded as one of the world's great lager conditioned beers.

Aktien-Brandbier Dunkel 5.3% £4.00

A dark, spicy beer typical of the Franconia region of Germany. Robust and full-bodied with a pleasantly mild carbon dioxide content. This beer comes in its natural state with a slight residue of yeast.

Aktien-Zwischl Kellerbier 5.3% £4.00

A natural, unfiltered beer with a yeasty cloudiness. This German 'keller bier' contains all the ingredients which are normally filtered out, such as proteins, beer yeast and vitamins. Pleasantly hoppy and easy drinking.

William Bros' Caesar Augustus 4.1% £3.70

Golden straw in colour with a crisp, zesty zing and a dry finish.

Orval Abbey Beer 6.2% £3.70

Orval is a very dry, herby beer, which is ideal as an aperitif and characterised by a bouquet of fresh hops, with a fruity note and pronounced bitterness.

Veltins Pilsner 4.8% £2.70

Using natural spring water from its own mountain, Veltins has a superb delicate dry and clean palate with a fine carbonated body that gives a slight bitterness with a light citrus finish.

Bacchus Frambozen 4.5% £5.70

Bacchus Frambozen is a raspberry fruit beer, which has a refreshing and not-too-sweet palate followed by a spritzzy and tart finish.

Froach Heather Ale 5% £4.00

A light amber ale with floral peaty aroma, full malt character and a spicy herbal finish. This beer allows you to literally pour 4000 years of Scottish history into a glass!
