



Worcester Pub Beer Festival at The Cardinal's Hat

REAL ALE TASTING NOTES

| Brewer | Ale | ABV% | Style | Description | |
|------------------|----------------------|------|----------|---|---|
| Hereford Brewery | Mutts Nuts | 5.0 | Dark | Dark, rich, Hoppy, full bodied |  |
| Hereford Brewery | Laughing Dog | 4.2 | Amber | Let us know how you'd describe it! |  |
| Ledbury | Bitter | 3.8 | Copper | A traditional copper colour with a noticeably bitter start. Made with two local hops (Admiral and Progress) with the late addition hop providing an enjoyable finish with hints of spice. |  |
| Ledbury | Gold | 4.0 | Gold | Made using two local Herefordshire hops (First Gold and Fuggles), a golden bitter with a malt and hop combination that ensures it is well balanced with a honey and fru't finish. |  |
| Ledbury | Dr Rudi's Extra Pale | 4.1 | Gold | A golden straw-coloured, very easy drinking session beer. The Dr Rudi hop is from New Zealand and provides the beer with pine, lemongrass and fruit flavours. |  |
| Swan Brewery | Ruffled Feathers | 3.8 | Amber | An amber session ale with Herefordshire Cascade hops and a clean, crisp hop flavour that lingers. |  |
| Swan Brewery | Gold | 4 | Gold | A refreshing golden ale with Admiral and light floral notes of Saaz and Wolf hops. |  |
| Swan Brewery | Black Swan | 4.5 | Stout | A roasted coffee stout with a blend of 5 grains in the grist. |  |
| Swan Brewery | Blond | 3.7 | Blond | Swan Brewery's refreshing, light, spring special with Herefordshire Cascade, Ernest and Goldings hops. |  |
| Teme Valley | That | 4.1 | Chestnut | A chestnut coloured best bitter with a robust malt flavour balanced by powerful hops. We use crystal malt, chocolate malt and Challenger and Sovereign hops. One for real ale connoisseurs. |  |
| Teme Valley | T'Other | 3.5 | Pale | A pale beer brewed using Challenger and Goldings hops to give a delicate aroma and a gentle bitterness. Amber malt contributes a light biscuit flavour. One of Roaer Protz's top 50 micro brewers' cask ales. |  |
| Teme Valley | Talbot Blond | 4.4 | Gold | A smooth, rich golden beer well hopped with Worcestershire Pilgrim and Minstrel. |  |
