Brewer	Ale	ABV%	Style	Description	
Brew 61	BDA	4	Dark	A full bodied English dark ale, with a strong malt palate and a smooth chocolate finish.	
Brew 61	Black Bull	4.5	Rye IPA	This Black Rye IPA is rich and dark with coffee and chocolate aroma, a full mouthfeel of roasted malt and subtle spice and a refreshingly light citrus finish	
Hop Shed	3 Kings	4.4	Stout	A dry stout with new English hop Mystic, resulting in an easy drinking beer with flavours of chocolate, coffee, blackcurrant and orange.	
North Cotswold	Jumping Jack Flash	3.8	Pale	Crisp, hoppy, refreshing pale with hints of tropical fruit.	
North Cotswold	Winter Solstice	4.5	Ruby	A deep ruby easy drinking winter warmer, brewed with American hops.	
Teme Valley	Talbot Porter	4.4	Stout	A silky smooth deep coloured porter brewed using Northdown hops for an unusual nutty hop flavour.	
Teme Valley	T'Other	3.5	Pale	A pale beer brewed using Challenger and Goldings hops to give a delicate aroma and a gentle bitterness. Amber malt contributes a light biscuit flavour.	
Wye Valley	Butty Bach	4.5	Gold	Charmingly smooth premium brewed using Maris Otter and Crystal malts together with locally grown Fuggles, Goldings and Bramling Cross hops.

Barkers	Victorian Orchard Perry	6.5	Perry	Hazy, pale yellow colour. Aroma is woody and has some barnyard and yeast too. <b>It's tart but fruity and refreshing.</b>	
Celtic Marches	Celtic Tiger	3.4	Fruit	Pineapple brings a refreshing balance of sweet and sour to the blend, complimenting the light citrus burst of the orange and still allowing the pressed apple afternotes to break through.	
Celtic Marches	Loubi Lou	4	Medium Sweet	Herefordshire Cider liberally imparted with pomegranate and rose. The orchard & the Garden give a quintessential taste of the English Summer.	
Celtic Marches	Tutti Fruity	3.4	Fruit	Deliciously moreish exotic flavour. The balance of the sweet and tartness of the pineapple partners perfectly with the richness of cherry. With a light mouthfeel this is a seamlessly complex fruit cider.	
Fleece Inn	Ark	6	Medium Dry	Lovingly made each year at the Apple and Ale weekend, using cider fruit and apples from our own orchard and local's trees.	
Hogan's	French Revelation	4.8	Breton	A revelation by name and by nature, this is something a little different. This fresh pressed drop is smooth & velvety with a big tannic punch followed by fruit sweetness.	
Hogan's	Harvest Press	5.3	Medium Day	Appley aroma with peaty undertones, this medium dry cider is just challenging enough to be easy drinking. A real taste of the orchard.	
Hogan's	Libertine	6.2	Bitter Sweet	Indulgent, sweetly satisfying cider. Burnt umber in colour, dark, bittersweet, warming Libertine is a rich, tannic cider with unusual depth. Satisfying, exotic and grown up.	
Thatchers - Stan's	Cheddar Valley	6.6	Medium	Distinctive orange hues, a smooth, robust, naturally <b>cloudy</b> cider. Apples including Tremlett's Bitter for its tannins, while Dabinett brings a rich, full body.
